Antonio Margarito has a great chin and wears down his opponents by stalking them. He did it in perfect fashion against Cotto. If he goes in with a similar game plan against Mosley, he will get his hand raised yet again in a dominating performance. The punch output that Margarito brings will wear on the older Mosley and could make for a one sided victory.

Experience is going to be a huge key in this fight. Shane Mosley has been in a lot of big time fights, both as the favorite and as the underdog. Antonio Margarito has always been the challenger looking to get to the top. He is now the hunted and considered a top five pound for pound fighter.
